Happy Hour at the Firehouse Lounge with Bill Deasy



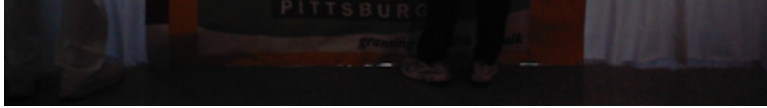
